The *National Climate Resilience and Adaptation Strategy* identifies priorities for future action across a range of sectors and policy areas. Adapting to the impacts of climate change is a responsibility shared by governments of all levels, business, communities and households. The Australian Government has an important ongoing role to play in providing climate research and information that can help decision-makers at all levels plan for and manage the impacts of climate change. The Government does this through a range of investments, including through the CSIRO and Bureau of Meteorology.
