What is the highest and lowest credit limit for each type of card?

## Answer:

Department of the Environment and Energy

The Departments standard credit card limits are as follows:

Non-SES \$2,000 per transaction \$5,000 per month

SES \$5,000 per transaction \$10,000 per month

Exemptions to the standard limits to cater for exceptional circumstances may be sought, supported by a business case, for approval by the Chief Operating Officer or the Chief Finance Officer. Currently the highest credit card limit is \$30,000.

Cab charge, Fast card and Cab charge eTicket limits are unrestricted, however individuals must sign for each charge and their use is restricted to taxis for business requirements.
