What percentage of a tonne of emissions reductions is achieved by an ACCU (or per MWh of generation)?

## Answer:

One Australian carbon credit unit (ACCU) represents one tonne of carbon dioxide sequestered or avoided under the Emissions Reduction Fund. The Clean Energy Regulator is unable to respond to the question regarding a MWh of generation – refer to Question on Notice number 321.
