Senator Urquhart, Anne asked:

In the recent estimates hearing, Mr Costello said that Tasmanian regional NRM bodies used 'some other funding' to 'run workshops and other things on rehabilitation.' Can you provide further detail on the dates, locations, content and funding sources for each of these projects?

Answer:

NRM Cradle Coast and NRM North assisted with/facilitated meetings and workshops following the June 2016 flood event that were funded from other sources, and have provided support to the Tasmanian Government Flood Recovery Taskforce.

NRM Cradle Coast advised the Department that to date, they have developed one partnership project, and supported 8 events and 5 meetings attended by a total of 279 participants. These were:

NRM North advised the Department that NRM North officers and NRM local government facilitators (all NLP funded) worked with the Tasmanian Government Flood Recovery Taskforce to provide support that has included:

- Nine referrals from the Taskforce over July and August that resulted in desktop and/or site assessments. NRM North staff assessed riverbank erosion on four properties. They also facilitated the involvement of Conservation Volunteers Australia and a Green Army crew to assist with debris clean up and site restoration.
- Conservation Volunteers Australia also engaged NRM North in October to advise on riverbank erosion stabilisation on the North Esk River. NRM North subsequently provided 500 plants for riparian revegetation works (NLP funded through the 20 Million Trees initiative).
