Senator BUSHBY asked:

990. How much was spent on 2013 Graduate Training? Provide details of what training was provided, why and the estimated cost for each.

Answer:

990. The expected cost of the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority's (APRA's) 2013 graduate training program is \$50,050. The program delivers a range of technical and interpersonal skills training to enable graduates to perform their roles effectively. All technical training is delivered internally by APRA subject matter experts and incurs no direct costs. The estimated cost of delivering training is \$3,127.50 per graduate.
