Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 1820. How many Ministers have you had in the past three years before the election and in particular in the year preceding the election?
- 1821. What costs or disruption have you faced from pre-election changes of Ministers, whether IT costs, preparation of new briefings, changes of style guides and information products to suit new Ministers?

Answer:

- 1820. The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) had one responsible Minister in the three years prior to the 2013 election.
- 1821. The ACCC's responsible Minister did not change prior to the 2013 election.
