- 2060. How many officers were responsible for preparing the department, agency, Minister or representing Minister's briefing pack for the purposes of senate estimates?
- 2061. How many officer hours were spent on preparing that information?
 - a. Please break down the hours by officer APS classification
- 2062. Were drafts shown to the Minister or their office before senate estimates?
 - a. If so, when did this occur?
 - b. How many versions of this information were shown to the minister or their office?
- 2063. Did the minister or their office make any contributions, edits or suggestions for departmental changes to this information?
 - a. If so, when did this occur?
- b. What officer hours were spent on making these edits? Please break down the hours by officer APS classification.
 - c. When were the changes made?
- 2064. Provide each of the contents page of the Department/Minister/representing Minister's Senate Estimates folder prepared by the department for the Additional Estimates hearings in February 2014.

Answer:

- 2060. Two staff were responsible for preparing the Senate estimates briefing packs for the ACNC's SES staff appearing at the February 2014 Senate Estimates briefings.
- 2061. The ACNC estimates 34 officer hours were spent preparing information.
 - a) 15 hours of one APS6, 10 hours of one EL2, 3 hours of two SES Band 1, and 3 hours of one SES Band 2.
- 2062. The ACNC's Senate estimates briefing packs were not sent to the Minister's office.
- 2063. Per the response for question 3, the Minister's Office did not make any contributions or edits.
- 2064. Information on briefing provided to Minister's is not normally made publically available in order to maintain Agencies' ability to properly and effectively brief Ministers.
