Actuarial Study into Strata Title Insurance Prices in North Queensland. Commissioned on 16 December 2013. The report is to be completed in the first half of 2014. The Australian Government Actuary (AGA) has been requested to investigate the causes of strata property insurance premium increases in North Queensland over the period 2005-06 to 2012-13, and make comparisons with strata insurance pricing across Northern Australia more broadly as well as other east coast centres, including Adelaide, Sydney and Melbourne. The report is to be undertaken by the AGA; as such, there are no committee members.

- a. The report is being undertaken by existing Treasury staff (the AGA) and therefore will not incur additional costs in terms of personnel. An SES B1 and an APS 6 will be undertaking the report. It is estimated that the report will 188 work hours will be required to complete the report.
- b. The report is to be completed in the first half of 2014. The Government will review the report once received.
