663. Is electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive) provided to department/agency staff? If yes provide a list of what is provided across the department of agency, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost and a breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

Answer:

663. Yes, the Commission provides the following electronic equipment to agency employees:

iPhone (or other mobile phone)	869	\$816
iPad	598	\$588
Wireless card	\$178	\$552
