Senator LUDWIG asked:

- 835. How many ongoing staff recruited from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 836. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 837. From Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

- 835. There were 53 ongoing staff (excluding ABS Interviewers) recruited between 26 November 2013 and 5 March 2014. Of these; 51 were at the APS level (includes 44 staff as part of the 2014 Graduate intake) and two at the Executive Level (EL2). Additionally, there were nine non-ongoing or Cadet staff who were successful in gaining an ongoing APS level position in the 2014 ABS Graduate intake during this period.
- 836. As at 5 March 2014 there were 124 non-ongoing staff employed by the ABS, compared with 156 as at 25 November 2013 (excluding ABS Interviewers). Please see the following table for comparison of levels.
