#### Senator LUDWIG asked:

900. For Departments and Agencies with Boards, Since September 7th 2013;

- a. how often has each board met, break down by board name;
- b. what travel expenses are provided;
- c. what is the average attendance at board meetings;
- d. how does the board deal with conflict of interest;
- e. what conflicts of interest have been registered;
- f. what remuneration is provided to board members;
- g. how does the board dismiss board members who do not meet attendance standards?
- h. Have any requests been made to ministers to dismiss board members since September 7, 2013?
- i. Please list board members who have attended less than 51% of meetings
- j. what have catering costs been for the board meetings held this year; is alcohol served?

#### **Answer:**

900.

- a. The Australian Statistics Advisory Council (ASAC) met once.
- b. If travel is required the ABS provides for return airfares and transfers, accommodation (if required), meals, (less any meals that are provided for by the ABS) and incidentals.
- c. 18 members present, three members provided apologies.
- d. ASAC members who are appointed by the Australian Government must declare any private interests. State and territory representatives are currently all state/territory public servants bound by their respective state/territory government legislation.
- e. No conflicts of interest have been registered.
- f. ASAC Chair \$30,080, as set by the Remuneration Tribunal Determination, Remuneration and Allowances for holders of part-time public office.
- g. Under section 20(2) of the *Australian Bureau of Statistics Act 1975*, the Minister may remove a member from office for misbehaviour or physical or mental incapacity.
