Question:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1934. Has electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive, video cameras) been provided by the department/agency to departmental staff? If yes provide a list of:

- 1935. What has been provided?
- 1936. The purchase cost.
- 1937. The ongoing cost.
- 1938. A list of any accessories provided for the equipment and the cost of those accessories. (e.g. iPad keyboards, laptop carry bags, additional chargers etc).
- 1939. A breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

Answer:

- 1934. Yes.
- 1935. RSA tokens and USB sticks are available to staff at the SES 1, EL 1/2, APS 5/6 classification levels for use in the field and a laptop is provided to the Risk and Operations Manager (EL1) and Office Manager (APS 6) as part of the agency's Business Continuity Plan. The Inspector-General of Taxation and the Deputy Inspector-General have access to an iPad and iPhone for business requirements so that they may be contactable at any time and/or require remote access to agency resources. iPhones are also available to staff at the SES 1 and EL 1/2 classification levels for use in the field.
- 1936. The costs and maintenance relating to the acquisition of these electronic devices is managed by the Department of Treasury under a service level agreement with the Inspector-General of Taxation.
