## **Question:**

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1940. Has electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive, video cameras) been provided by the department/agency to departmental staff? If yes provide a list of:

1941. What has been provided?

1942. The purchase cost.

1943. The ongoing cost.

1944. A list of any accessories provided for the equipment and the cost of those accessories. (e.g. iPad keyboards, laptop carry bags, additional chargers etc).

1945. A breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

#### Answer:

As at 19 February 2016:

1940-1945. Yes, the Commission provides the following electronic equipment to agency employees:
