### **Ouestion:**

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 3258. How many requests for documents under the FOI Act have been received?
- 3259. Of these, how many documents have been determined to be deliberative documents?
- 3260. Of those assessed as deliberative documents:
- a) For how many has access to the document been refused on the basis that it would be contrary to the public interest?
- b) For how many has a redacted document been provided?

#### **Answer:**

- 3258. 47 FOI requests were received by Treasury during the period 14 September 2015 and 19 February 2016.
- 3259. For three requests a total of nine documents have been determined to be deliberative. 3260.
- (a) Of the nine documents assessed as being deliberative documents, access to the document has been refused for one.
- (b) Eight documents for which the section 47C deliberative exemption was applied have been released in redacted form.
