## **Question:**

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 3276. How many requests for documents under the FOI Act have been received?
- 3277. Of these, how many documents have been determined to be deliberative documents?
- 3278. Of those assessed as deliberative documents:
- a) For how many has access to the document been refused on the basis that it would be contrary to the public interest?
- b) For how many has a redacted document been provided?

#### **Answer:**

- 3276. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) received 26 requests for documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act) during the period 14 September 2015 to 10 February 2016.
- 3277. Of the 26 requests, APRA has refused access to documents in response to one request on the basis that the documents are deliberative documents.
- 3278. a) APRA has refused access to documents in response to one request on the basis that the documents are deliberative documents and disclosure would be contrary to the public interest.
