- a) Various indoor office plants leased for office premises in the Treasury Building Langton Crescent Canberra and the Office of the Small Business Commissioner Level 2, 15 Moore St Canberra.
- b) Total cost for the period 1 September to 29 February was \$13,644.97.
- c) \$13,164.63 for indoor office plants in the Treasury Building Langton Crescent Canberra and \$480.34 for indoor office plants for the Office of the Small Business Commissioner Level 2 15 Moore Street Canberra.
- d) The indoor office plants are leased from Tropical Foliage Pty Ltd trading as Living Simply.
- e) A contract was established via a piggy back agreement with the Civil Aviation Safety Authority in October 2014.
- f) Treasury Building Langton Crescent Canberra and Level 2, 15 Moore St Canberra.
