## 3715.

Austrade, through Tourism Research Australia, consulted extensively with a range of stakeholders prior to the Proof of Concept project being commissioned. Austrade have provided details of this engagement within their submission.

### 3716.

The Proof of Concept project began in late August 2015.

## 3717.

Austrade engaged the ABS to undertake this project. A Letter of Intent between both Agencies was developed to specify the project requirements. Austrade was heavily involved throughout the entirety of the project.

## 3718.

The request was received by ABS in July 2015.

#### 3719.

The final report has been delivered to Austrade. They will attach the report to their submission.

#### 3720.

Austrade is undertaking all Ministerial and Inter-departmental engagement in relation to the project.

#### 3721.

This decision rests with the Government.

#### 3722.

The cost of conducting the 2015-16 Survey of Tourist Accommodation on an annual basis is approximately \$550,000.

### 3723.

The data for the STA needs to be collected from July to September 2016 in order for the 2015-16 financial year results to be published in November 2016.

#### 3724.

Minister Colbeck met with Austrade on 15 March 2016.
