- The total amount payable by the Commonwealth to New South Wales under the agreement signed with NSW on 5 March 2015 is \$1,965 million, subject to achievement by NSW of all milestones set out in Table B2 of Schedule B to the National Partnership Agreement on Asset Recycling and satisfaction of the conditions specified at clause B5 of Schedule B.
