## **Question:**

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

842. How much did each department/agency spend on hire cars during the specified period? Provide a breakdown of each business group in each department/agency.

843. What are the reasons for hire car costs?

844. How much did the department spend on hire cars during the specified period for their minister or minister's office?

#### Answer:

842. From 1 September 2015 to 31 January 2016 the ATO (including the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission, Australian Business Register and Tax Practitioners Board) spent \$43,956 (GST exclusive) on hire cars.

\* People, Systems and Services incurs hire car expenses on behalf of other ATO business areas where fleet vehicles are not available and hire cars are organised as an alternative means of travel.

- 843. The ATO utilises short-term vehicle hire contracts as an alternative source of transport, where fleet vehicles are not available, and it is more cost effective than other forms of transport.
- 844. The ATO does not pay for hire cars for the minister or the minister's office.
