QUESTION No.: AI-100

- 1. How much did the Department spend on stationery and office supplies (excluding paper) in calendar year 2016 (GST inclusive)?
- 2. How much did the Department spend on paper in calendar year 2016 (GST inclusive)?
- 3. What brand of paper does the Department use?
- 4. Is this paper Australian made?
- 5. If no, why doesn't the Department buy Australian made paper?

ANSWER

- 1. The Department's spend on stationery and office supplies (excluding paper) was \$336,616 in the 2016 calendar year (GST inclusive).
- 2. The Department's spend on paper was \$126,993 in 2016 calendar year (GST inclusive).
- 3. The Department has undertaken a desktop value for money assessment of all the paper products available under the mandatory Whole of Government stationery and office supplies arrangement. A range of factors including fitness for purpose, quality of the product, availability, price and environmental and social considerations were considered.

As a result of the assessment, only the purchase of Reflex (from Staples) and Australian Paper (from Complete Office Supplies) is currently permitted.

- 4. Yes. Both of these brands are Australian made.
