What's the current average staffing level (ASL) in in the Department? Of these, how many are non-APS employees and how many are consultants? Please provide a breakdown of total ASL, non-APS employees and consultants by Division.

ANSWER

- The Department's budgeted Average Staffing Level (ASL) for 2016-17 is 2,450 as outlined on page 11 of the Portfolio Additional Estimates Statements. The ASL is impacted by the transfer of the energy functions to the Department of the Environment and Energy as a result of the 19 July and 1 September 2016 Administrative Arrangement Orders.
- The Department's full time equivalent (FTE) staffing level as at 23 March 2017 is 2,433. A breakdown of FTE by division is outlined below.
