### **Question:**

- 1. When was the request received by the ATO for a change in GST status from One Nation? (One Nation Queensland Division has the ABN (ABN) 53 975 273 862)
- 2. Who was in charge of evaluating the request?
- 3. At what time did the change from unregistered to registered occur?
- 4. How soon after this change in status would the ABN Look Up web site feature the amended entry?
- 5. The entry on ABN look up states that the entity has an active GST status.
- 6. The date from which this status is said to be active is 1 July 2015. Why is this status active from 1 July 2015 and not 2 March 2017?

Generally an entity can apply to the ATO for retrospective GST registration. If they do this they may be liable for general interest charge and penalties.
