2. The Treasurer was accompanied by one Senior Adviser and one Media Adviser from his office. Four Treasury officials (three Canberra-based and one official posted to the UK) with classification levels of SESB3, SESB1 x 2 and EL1 supported the Treasurer at these meetings.

With respect to the Treasurer and accompanying advisers all overseas travel is undertaken in line with the Members of Parliament (Staff) Act 1984 and paid for by the Department of Finance. Dates, destinations, the purpose and costs of all official overseas visits are tabled in the Parliament every six months in a report titled Parliamentarians' Expenditure paid by the Department of Finance and its supporting information. The reports and supporting information are also published on the Department of Finance website.
