Topic: First Home Owners Grant

Senator PAYNE asked:

343. Can you please provide current and historical data (based on the regularity you receive figures) on the numbers and costs of the First Home Owners Grant (and, during the relevant periods, the First Home Owners Boost), broken down by: jurisdiction; the cost of dwellings to which the FHOG was applied; and whether the dwelling was an existing dwelling or a newly constructed/off-the-plan dwelling.

Answer:

The First Home Owners Scheme (FHOS) is administered and funded by the States and Territories (the States). The data are the property of the States and are not able to be released by the Commonwealth Treasury. Some States publish FHOS data on their Office of State Revenue websites. Historical FHOS data was published by the COAG Reform Council in their National Affordable Housing Agreement: Baseline performance reports for 2008-09 and 2009-10.

Data related to the First Home Owners Boost (FHOB) is collected by the States as part of their administrative role under the *National Partnership Agreement on the First Home Owners Boost* and the *National Partnership Agreement on Extending the First Home Owners Boost* (the Agreements). Data on the FHOB are at Attachment A.

Data are not available on the purchase price of the property to which the grant was applied. As outlined in the *Intergovernmental Agreement on Federal Financial Relations* the FHOS is not means tested. However, States are able to set a cap on the value of property purchased in order for an applicant to be eligible for a FHOS grant. All States, except for Tasmania, have set a cap. Information on individual States can be found on their revenue office websites.
