**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

485. How many ongoing staff have been recruited this financial year to date? What classification are these staff?
486. How many non ongoing positions exist or have been created this financial year to date? What classification are these staff?
487. This financial year to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

**Answer:**

485. Two  
1 x APS6, 1 x EL1
486. Four positions are occupied by non-ongoing employees.  
No non-ongoing positions have been created in the financial year, however three employees began non-ongoing contracts in the financial year.  
1 x APS6, 2 x EL2, 1 x SES3
487. Four staff are employed on contract. Three contracts began in 2011/12. Contracts duration is 2, 3 or 5 years.
