Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 923. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date?
- 924. What is the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date?
- 925. What was the department/agency's stationery costs for 2009-10 and 2010-11?

Answer:

- 923. The total spend on Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries stationery requirements for the financial year to 31-May-2012 was \$33,022.
- 924. The total spend on the Treasury's stationery costs for the financial year to 31-May-2012 was \$224,871.
- 925. The total spend on the Treasury's stationery costs for the financial year 2009-10 was \$336,038 and \$327,273 for 2010-11.
