Senator BUSHBY asked:

932. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date?
933. What is the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date?
934. What was the department/agency's stationery costs for 2009-10 and 2010-11?

Answer:

932. The ACCC does not provide stationery to Ministers, Parliamentary Secretaries or their offices.
933. The ACCC's expenditure on stationery, stores and consumables totalled \$111 235 for the financial year to date (1 July 2011 to 31 May 2012).
934. \$112 917 in 2009-10 and \$116 905 in 2010-11.
