Topic: Stationery requirements (ATO)

Senator BUSHBY asked:

944. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date?
945. What is the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date?
946. What was the department/agency's stationery costs for 2009-10 and 2010-11?

Answer:

944. For the 2011-12 financial year to 31 May 2012, the ATO spent \$1,173.70 including GST on stationery requirements for the Treasury Portfolio Ministers.
945. For the 2011-12 financial year to 31 May 2012, the ATO spent \$2.9 million on stationery.
946. For the 2009-10 and 2010-11 financial years, ATO expenditure on stationery was:
