 - a 9-month study on Regulator Engagement with Small Business (reference received
 7 December 2012);
 - a 12-month study on Major Project Development Assessment Processes (reference received 7 December 2012); and
 - a 12-month study on Geographic Labour Mobility (reference received 21 May 2013).
