Senator BUSHBY asked:

448. Provide an update for your department/agency, including what is your current compliance level, what are you doing to manage risk, what is being done to comply with the mandatory requirements and details of any department/agency specific policies and procedures.

Answer:

448. Agencies have until 1 August 2013 to comply with the Protective Security Policy Framework (SPF). The Treasury will be compliant.
All internal security policies required by the PSPF have been written. Policies on governance personal security were endorsed by management in May 2013. Policies on information and physical security will be finalised during July 2013.
