ANSWER

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY

1. The Department owns 14 vehicles as at 30 June 2014.
2. Please refer to the table below for the location of the vehicles. Vehicles are used for the transportation of equipment for field work, the collection of goods and travel to remote locations.

3 and 4. The below table provides details on owned cars for the period 1 March to 30 June 2014.

5. The Department leases 154 vehicles as at 30 June 2014.
6. The Department's leased vehicles are located in each State and Territory in Australia.
7. The Department's fleet consists of 75 National Trade Measurement vehicles and 36 pool vehicles which are used for the transportation of equipment for field work, for the collection and delivery of goods and for travel to remote locations. In addition there are 18 AusIndustry Regional Manager vehicles and 25 Executive Scheme Vehicles (SES officers).

8 and 9. The total cost of the 154 leased vehicles from 1 March to 30 June 2014 was \$845,415. The total kilometres travelled by the leased vehicles was approximately 743,407 kilometres. To provide this data on an individual vehicle basis would be a significant diversion of departmental and agency resources.
