- 1. How many Co-operative research centres is CSIRO involved in? What is the nature of the involvement?
- 2. Can CSIRO list its level of investment in each co-operative Research Centre?
- 3. Was CSIRO involved in any bids, or was considering involvement in any, for the 17th round of the CRC Program which has now been cancelled? If yes, please list the bids.

ANSWER

- 1. CSIRO is active in 20 of the current 38 CRCs. CSIRO's engagement differs between CRCs dependent on the proportion of the CRC activities that are conducted by CSIRO. In some cases CSIRO is a foundation member of the CRC, in others the relationship may be on an individual project level.
- 2. CSIRO's direct life to date contribution for the 20 CRC's CSIRO was actively involved with as at 30 June 2013 is detailed below (actual figures for the 2013-14 financial year were not finalised at the time of preparing the response and therefore could not be included):
