Question:

1116. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed from additional Estimates in February 2014 to date? How many of these printed documents were also published online?
1117. Did the Department/agency use external printing services for any print jobs since February 2014?
- a) If so, what companies were used?
 - b) How were they selected?
 - c) What was the total cost of this printing?

Answer:

1116. Since 28 February 2014, Treasury has had 50 documents professionally printed. A total of 53,279 copies were made (including Budget and annual report documents). All bar five documents were published online; exceptions included G20 delegate and liaison officer handbooks, a performance management handbook and an after-hours contact directory.
1117. Yes.
- a) Companies used were CanPrint, Paragon Printing, Focus Press and Instant Colour Press.
 - b) The providers were selected by way of prequalified tender under the printing and production multi-use list (MUL), under the collaborative procurement program for print and related services managed by the Department of Human Services and through three quotes, best value for money process.
 - c) Total cost was \$190,821.57.
