## Question

- 1767. How many ongoing staff were recruited from Additional Estimates in February, 2014 to date\*? What classification are these staff?
- 1768. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from Additional Estimates in February, 2014 to date\*? What classification are these staff?
- 1769. From Additional Estimates in February, 2014 to date\*, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

\* period 28 February to 12 June 2014

## Answer:

1767. In the period 28 February to 12 June 2014, the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) recruited five permanent staff. The staff were employed at the following APRA classification levels:

Level 2	2
Level 3	1
Level 4	2
Total staff	5

- 1768. APRA does not create non-ongoing positions. APRA fills roles either permanently or on a fixed-term basis.
- 1769. In the period 28 February to 12 June 2014 APRA employed four fixed-term employees, three of whom were employed for less than 12 months, and one for greater than 12 months.
