Questions:

1946. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date? How many of these printed documents were also published online?
1947. Did the Department/agency use external printing services for any print jobs since 7 September 2013?
- If so, what companies were used?
 - How were they selected?
 - What was the total cost of this printing?

Answers:

1946. From November 2013 to June 2014 ASIC's Financial Literacy team printed 13 documents, as follows:

1947. Yes.
- CanPrint Communications Pty Ltd and ADM Solutions Pty Ltd, for the documents listed above. SMPC Pty Ltd were also engaged to print 200 school fence banners for the MoneySmart Teaching program.
 - The providers were selected from the Centrelink Printing and Production Services Multi Use List, using a competitive procurement process against other suppliers.
 - The total cost of printing the documents above was \$154,430 including GST. The MoneySmart Teaching school fence banners cost \$15,690 including GST.
