Question:

2112. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed since Additional Estimates in February 2014 to date? How many of these printed documents were also published online?
2113. Did the Department/agency use external printing services for any print jobs since Additional Estimates in February 2014?
- If so, what companies were used?
 - How were they selected?
 - What was the total cost of this printing?

Answer:

2112. From 26 February to 31 May 2014, 179,550,410 individual items were printed at a cost of \$3,286,027 (GST inclusive).

Of these items the main products were:

2113. All products were printed using external suppliers. These suppliers are members of the ATO's printing, mail out and related services panel.
