- a). The CEFC typically engages hire cars for the following reasons:
- The CEFC is primarily based in Sydney & Brisbane and services the country nationally from these offices.
- The CEFC does not own, lease or operate a corporate fleet of vehicles.
- The CEFC does not offer any car parks to staff.
- The CEFC does not pay an allowance for vehicle purchase or leasing.
- Unsuitability or unavailability of public transport (including taxis), due to scheduling, route, safety, expense or other reasons.
- In many instances, hire car services are a more effective use of funds that enables staff members to be more productive than if they were waiting for scheduled public transport services between meetings.
- Efficiencies in travelling as a group, rather than having separate pick-up and drop off from individual taxis.
- Tight schedules between engagements and/or a requirement to have driver pick up luggage while hirer is engaged in other work.
