2235. Please detail how much electrical equipment, phones and computers the department/agency has in storage or unallocated to staff.

2236. Please detail the purchase, storage and ongoing costs associated with equipment, phones and computers in storage or unallocated.

**Answer:**

2235. The CEFC carries a small stock of unallocated phones and computers to cover changes in staffing levels and equipment failures. These are typically obsolete equipment that has been deliberately retained for such contingency.

- Electrical equipment – None.
- Laptop computers - less than 5 on average.
- Other computers – None.
- Mobile phones - less than 5 on average.
- Desk phones – None.

All of the CEFC's equipment whether allocated or unallocated is typically stored at the CEFC's premises in either Sydney and Brisbane, except when in use off premises.
