Answer:

712. In the 2012-13 financial year, there were 581 agricultural entities (entities reporting using the Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification code of Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing) who claimed in excess of \$100,000 in credits under the fuel tax credits scheme.
