**Senator WHISH-WILSON asked:** Could I get an idea from the Treasury officials what number of agricultural entities claim more than \$100,000 a year in credits currently?

**Senator WHISH-WILSON:** What number of agricultural entities claim more than \$100,000 in credits a year under the scheme?

Mr Heferen: We will have to take it on notice.

## **Answer:**

712. In the 2012-13 financial year, there were 581 agricultural entities (entities reporting using the Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification code of Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing) who claimed in excess of \$100,000 in credits under the fuel tax credits scheme.
