**TOPIC:** Anti-Dumping Reforms

**REFERENCE:** Written Question – Senator Ketter

**QUESTION No.:** BI-2

Senator KETTER: On 18 February, Minister Pyne issued a press release stating that the government had initiated the second stage of its antidumping reforms, which included asking the Anti-Dumping Commission to report on the impact of Asian steelmakers on the Australian market. During the Senate inquiry on the steel industry, the Anti-Dumping Commissioner told the committee that the report was given to the minister on 4 April.

Is that correct?

Mr Seymour: Yes, that is correct.

Senator KETTER: If that is the case, I note that the minister has had the report for over a month.

When will it be released?

Mr Lawson: That is a matter for the minister. We have been conducting consultations with industry since the report was provided to the minister.

Senator KETTER: Right. In relation to the International Trade Remedies Forum, under the Customs Act this group is required to meet twice a year. Is that correct?

Mr Seymour: That is correct.

Senator KETTER: And when did the forum last meet?

Mr Seymour: In December of last year.

Senator KETTER: How many times has the forum met since the last election?

Mr Seymour: From memory, I am going to say three times, but I would like to go back and check the record to ensure that I am correct in that.

Senator KETTER: That obviously is at odds with the statutory requirement—is that correct?

Mr Seymour: The Customs Act requires that the forum meet twice each calendar year.

Ms Beauchamp: If I could add to that. The government held two meetings of the forum in 2015—17 August and 2 December.

Senator KETTER: And in 2014?

Ms Beauchamp: As the commissioner has said, we would have to look back that far.

Senator KETTER: You do not believe that they did meet?

Ms Beauchamp: I am not sure. I would have to have a look.

Senator KETTER: The commissioner has indicated that potentially there have been three meetings since September 2013. Ms Beauchamp, are you able to tell us how this situation might be rectified? Ms Beauchamp: I do not know if there is a position to be rectified. As the commissioner has said, the last meeting was in December and the next one is to be scheduled.

Senator KETTER: The commissioner has told us that, to the best of his recollection, there could have been three.

Senator Canavan: We have taken that on notice. We will get that information to you.

## **ANSWER**

No meetings of the International Trade Remedies Forum were held in 2014. The Forum met twice in 2015, in August and December.
