What is the new compliance regime that AAHL will operate under?

## **ANSWER**

The Department of Agriculture and Water Resources has updated the AAHL compliance requirements to be consistent with the *Biosecurity Act 2015*. These requirements continue to be monitored under an audit regime which rewards good compliance with a reduction in audits, and low compliance with increased audits and a resulting higher presence at a particular facility. Biosecurity Industry Participants (BIPs) such as CSIRO can apply for variations to requirements where it can be demonstrated that a facility is effectively managing the biocontainment risk through alternative engineering or procedural processes. This risk-based compliance process reflects the complex and unique containment features of a range of facilities including AAHL, allowing, where possible a more tailored, risk-matched way, rather than a one-size fits all regulatory compliance regime.
