## **Question:**

1. I refer to the 2016-17 MYEFO measure that would see the ATO provide tax debt information to credit reporting bureaus.

"The measure is slated to begin operation on 1 July 2017. However, we're yet to see any legislation in the Parliament, or an exposure draft on this measure."

- a. Is legislation still required for this measure to begin operation?
- 2. Has the Treasury allocated drafting resources, or has drafting commenced for the legislation to progress this measure?
- 3. Minister, perhaps this is a question best directed to you, is this measure still going to begin operation on 1 July 2017? Will we see legislation in the Parliament before the end of the Autumn sittings?
  - a. If yes, will this provide adequate time for the measure to be publicised?
