Senator ROBERTS: The cost of living is an issue that is hurting a lot of people amongst our constituents in Queensland and across Australia, especially in the underemployed that you mentioned in your comments. Could you give me your salary, including all entitlements and allowances, please?

Senator Cormann: I think that the salary of secretaries is actually published. I do not precisely know what it is, but the Remuneration Tribunal sets the salaries and relevant allowances of secretaries. I am pretty sure that that is actually published on the website of the Remuneration Tribunal. If it assists, I am happy to get you a copy of the relevant determination.

Senator ROBERTS: Okay, thank you—and all of the positions in Treasury that earn a salary of more than \$250,000 or more, including entitlements.

Senator Cormann: We will have to take that on notice to see how we can assist you with that.
