- a) How many ongoing staff recruited from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- b) How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification are these staff?
- c) From 7 September 2013 to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

669.

a) From 7 September to 30 November 2013, the ATO has recruited 187 ongoing staff, both full and part time, (including the Australian Valuation Office (AVO), Tax Practitioners Board (TPB), Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC) and Australian Business Register (ABR)).

- b) As at 30 November 2013, there were a total of 2934 non-ongoing (temporary) positions in existence.
 - 2722 (93%) were irregular/intermittent (casual) employees who are on call to work when required to assist with seasonal work peaks. If called in to work, irregular/intermittent employees have a minimum number of hours per shift (3 hours), but not a minimum or guaranteed number of shifts. Thus the hours worked (FTE) by irregular/intermittent employees is a fluctuating proportion of their headcount total.
 - 212 (7%) of the non-ongoing (temporary) positions were for Specific term employees with specified hours either full- or part-time.
