# Senator LUDWIG asked:

741.

- a) What are the details of the department/agency electricity purchasing agreement?
- b) What are the department/agency electricity costs from 7 September 2013 to date?

#### Answer:

741. a) The ATO has contractual agreements in place for sites where the ATO occupies more than 2,000 square metres. These agreements cover the provision of electricity.

Sites in Western Australia and the Northern Territory are not covered by contracts. In those sites, electricity is sourced by the building owner as per lease obligations.

b) For the period 7 September to 30 November 2013, ATO electricity costs were \$2,004,436.45.
