### Senators LUDWIG and WONG asked:

- 495. What is the Department/Agency's hospitality spend for all the events provided under 'Meeting Costs' including any catering and drinks costs.
- 496. What is the Department/Agency's entertainment spend from 7 September 2013 to date?

  Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 497. What hospitality spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 498. What entertainment spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 499. Is the Department/Agency planning on reducing any of its spending on these items? If so, how will reductions be achieved and what are they?

#### **Answer:**

- 495. The Australian Bureau of Statistics spent \$1,424.54 (exclusive of GST) from 1 September 2013 to 30 November 2013 on Hospitality and Entertainment under 'Meeting Costs' including any catering and drinks costs.
- 496. The Australian Bureau of Statistics spent \$1,586.18 (exclusive of GST) on hospitality and entertainment for the financial period from 1 September to 30 November 2013.

These amounts relate to expenditure used to facilitate the conduct of public business within and between Commonwealth agencies; or with external organisations and agencies; or with external organisations or individuals with related vocational, technical or business interests.

The date, location, purpose and cost of all events are listed in the attached Table 1.

497-499. Spending proposals are decided on a case by case basis with consideration of the purpose for hospitality/entertainment, which is to facilitate the conduct of public business within and between Commonwealth agencies; or with external organisations and agencies; or with external organisations or individuals with related vocational, technical or business interests.
