## Question: SBT 53

Topic: Trade Surplus 2007-13

## Senator WILLIAMS asked:

53. Senator WILLIAMS: Dr Parkinson, just looking back at the history of the terms of trade in Australia, I remember that in the nineties we were importing much more and exporting except at the stage between 1997 or 1998, when there was a big devaluation of the Australian dollar down to less than 50c. I think it hit 47.5c or something. Then we went into a trade surplus. From 2007 until 2013, we ran many trade surpluses. Is that correct? Dr Gruen: We have more recently run trade surpluses, but that is a development of the last couple of years. Before that, I think we ran trade deficits. We could check the details for you.

Senator WILLIAMS: Could you take on notice trade surpluses or deficits from that period 2007 until 2013 and give that to me so that I can just have a look at how we have been trading.

Dr Gruen: Certainly.

## Answer:

53. In the nineties Australia had 32 quarterly trade deficits and 8 quarterly trade surpluses. There were three consecutive trade surpluses in 1997 and one in 1996. This did coincide with the start of a depreciation of the Australian dollar.

Since the first quarter of 2007, Australia has had 18 quarterly trade deficits and 9 trade surpluses.
