Senator WRIGHT: Thank you for that. I have a feeling from the previous answers that I am going to be pushing my luck here, but would it be possible to tell who those charities are?

Ms Pascoe: No.

Senator WRIGHT: I see, I thought that might be the answer.

Answer:
