	Section 152EO that requires a review of the operation of Part XIC, which deals with telecommunications act, as well as of other provisions of the Act that relate to that Part. The review must be completed by 30 June 2014, and the review report must be tabled within 15 sitting days.	Section 208 requires a review of the operation of the Act to be undertaken commencing on the 2nd anniversary of the commencement of Chapter 3. The review must be completed within 6 months. The review report must be provided to the relevant Ministerial Council, and tabled within 15 sitting days of receipt (also 6 months of provision to the Council). Chapter 3 commenced on 1 July 2013.
